PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project "Volunteering and Specificity IX" arises from the idea of the capacity of volunteering to give us a positive vision of the people with disabilities, understanding this as the value of the person and their personal and differentiating qualities that procure the ability to develop and enrich the community context in which it operates; in such a way that it favors their participation and integration in normalized contexts.

The volunteers will carry out support tasks for people with disabilities in the province of Toledo through support actions in:

- Group sports activities;
- Individual sports activities;
- Educational support for the acquisition of study habits
- Promotion of leisure activities in standardized environments giving them access to standardized contexts to improve their quality of life
- Actions derived from the areas in which the Residential Support Program is intervened.



PLACE

The "Volunteering and Specificity IX" project is developed in the city of Toledo (Spain), located 70 km from the capital, Madrid, and perfectly connected with transport such as bus and Train.



Cecap Joven is located in the Buenavista neighborhood in the gallery of a Shopping Center, (Address: Ronda Buenavista 29, 45005), This place is a residential neighborhood where you can find buildings of certain official bodies, the National Police Station, as well as, professional services, clinics, shops, etc.,
